Thursday, June 17	Go to Pemberton Plaza, Attend The World of Coca-Cola and The Georgia Aquarium.
Friday, June 18	Visit The Jewish Heritage Museum from 10-3 p.m.
Saturday, June 19	Attend the Atlanta Fest, Christian Music Festival at Stone Mountain Park. Participate in Stone Mountain Park's

Sunday, June 20
